The Author of the Trust hereby appoints at the first instance the following persons as First Trustee to the Board of Trust.



4. NATURE OF THE TRUST

The Trust shall be Charitable Trust, having no commercial or profit motive.
The properties, securities, moneys and income or profits thereof shall be
applied solely for the purposes of the Trust without any discrimination of the

- The object and activities of the trust shall be carried out only in India.
- The Trust fund may be augmented mainly by the income from the initial fund and also from the income and contribution of the Trustees, well wishers and general public.
- The income or funds of the Trust will be utilized solely towards the objects of the Trust and no portion of it will be distributed in any manner to any person referred to in section 13 (c) of the Income Tax, 1961 or to any other trustees or members.

5.OBJECTS OF THE TRUST

The Trust is established for the charitable and benevolent advancement of all the people in India without any distribution of caste, religion, color, creed or community. This is proposed to be done in the following felids in the manner specified.

- TO ESTABLISH, run develop, maintain, support and grant aid in cash or in kind to an institute of Medical Sciences, Hospitals, Medical Schools, Dental Schools, Dental Colleges, Pharmacy Colleges, Nursing Colleges, Paramedical Institutions, Dispensators maternity homes, Child welfare centers, Researchtreatment and rehabilitation centers for Diabetes, Cardiac Nephrology, Neurology, Herbal Medicines, Aids and / or such other similar charitable institutions in India for the benefit and use of the general public
- TO ESTABLISH, orphanages, to provide food, shelter and education to the orphans, destitute children and abandoned children and to establish home for the aged and invalids.
- 3. TO ESTABLISH, run, support, maintain, and grand aid or other financial assistance to Schools, Arts and Science Colleges, Libraries, Reading rooms, Universities, Laboratories, Research and other institution of the like nature in India, for use of the student and the staff and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.
- TO ESTABLISH, maintain and run studentships, scholarships and render other mind of and to economically weaker students including supply of books, stipends, medical and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, color, religion, race, creed or sex.
- TO ESTABLISH, support, maintain, run or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts, for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions, in India, having similar objectives for the benefit of the public in general.

7. BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESPONSIBILITIES

THE TRUSTEES shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares
and funds as shall actually come into their hands basically from their own
earned money and trustees shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect,
default, act or omission or commission of the other person with whom the
trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.

THE TRUSTEES will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in

connection with the trust or their duties relating thereto.

THE NUMBER of Trustees shall not exceed seven.

- THE FOUNDER Trustees for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional principal Trustees.
- 5. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either
 - (a) If he/she dies
 - (b) If he/she becomes bankrupt
 - (c) If he/she becomes insanc or otherwise incapable to act

(d) If he/she resigns the office.

- THE TRUSTEES shall always maintain proper accounts of the trust, which shall be kept at the office of trust. Proper bank accounts are to be maintained and all the bank documents are also to be kept in the Trust office.
- 7. THE TRUSTEES will hold office till their lifetime
- 8. THE TRUSTEES may from time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meetings of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations, the Trustees will decide all matters mutually. Resolution passed without any meeting of the trustees but by circulation thereof and evidenced in writing under the hands of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a meeting of Trustees.
- 9. THE TRUSTEES shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the charity be conspired as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deemed to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.

10. All the Trustees will enjoy voting power and right, however, in case of tie, the Managing Trustees alone will get an additional vote to pass the resolution.

11. The Board of Trustees shall open account or accounts with any bank, nationalized, scheduled or co-operative bank or other banks and the accounts opened shall be operated by the President solely or jointly with Secretary or Treasurer or other office bearers as mutually decided in the meeting of the Trustee. A true copy of the resolution passed at the meeting shall be submitted to the bank as proof of authorization for opening and operation of bank account.

8. OFFICE BEARERS

The Board of Trustees shall elect among themselves the following office bearers.

- 1. President
- 2. Secretary
- 3. Treasurer

President - The Author and the Founder Trustee of this Trust, named herein above shall be a member of the Board of Trustees and President for life unless he voluntarily resigns.

Secretary - Dr. Poongothai Balaji will be first Secretary of the Trust

Treasurer - Mrs. Kamala Aruna will act as Treasurer

Apart from the above office bearers the Board of Trustees shall appoint an Executive Committee or Managing Committee to administer the day to day management of the Trust. The constitution of the Executive Committee will be decided now and then depending upon the task involved.

The Executive Committee will function under the advice of the Trustees.

9. POWERS OF THE TRUSTEES

FOR the furtherance of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers:

- TO APPLY the properties and funds of the Trust for all or any of the objects for which the Trust is established as may be determined by the Board of Trustees from time to time.
- TO CONVERT and deal with the Trust property and /or any investments for the time being.
- TO INVEST the funds of the trust in accordance with the provision of section 13(1) (d) read with section 11(5) of the Income tax. 1961.
- TO BORROW or raise or secure payments of moneys and also lend money either with or without security.
- TO SELL, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the trust fund, if deemed necessary after obtaining consent from all members of the trust. Alienation, if any, of the immovable property belonging to trust will be done after due intimation to the Director of Income tax (Exemptions).

- TO LET OUT, demise immovable property comprise in the Trust fund for such period and such rent on such terms and conditions as trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- 7. TO OPEN banking account, in the names of the Trust and or Institutions run/conducted by the Trust with any bank or banks and to operate such account and to give instructions to bank and to provide for opening and operation of such account by one or more of the trustees or by an agent appointed by trustees.

TO APPOINT advocate, solicitors to appear in any civil, criminal or revenue courts either to file plaint, written statement or any papers in any connected with such proceedings on behalf of the trust or to defend the trust in any case filed by others in respect of the trust property and matters connected with the trust.
- 11. TO APPOINT or make provision for the appointment of any persons (including all or any of the trustees and committees or administrator or managing trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subject such rules and regulation as trustees may prescribe and also to appoint or provide for the appointment of separate trustees to hold any fund or investments subject to provisions of this deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as trustees may from time to time think fit
- 12. TO MAKE vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and /or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the object of the trust.
- 13. TO START, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscriptions or donation made by them.
- 14. TO SET APART and / or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the trust fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the rust.
- 15. TO JOIN, co-operative or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or allied objects upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature of this trust.

- 21. TO MAKE OVER, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- 22. TO PURCHASE or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property assets, liabilities and engagements of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- 23. TO TRANSFER all or any part of the property assets, liabilities and engagements of this trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- 24. TO TRANSFER and hand over the trust to any other society, corporation, Institutions, Trust, or organization on such terms and conditions as the trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the society, corporation, institutions, trust or organization with the power, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents subjects to such transfer of trust fund, the trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharged from the trust here of relating to trust funds so transferred.

25. TO MAKE necessary amendments in the trust deed in accordance with the requirements of the time. However, such amendments shall be of the such a nature which would not alter the basic character and objects of the trust and further, no such amendments which may prove to be repugnant to the provisions of sections 2(15), 11&13 and 80G of the income tax act shall be made.

10. PROCEEDINGS OF THE TRUST

- i. The trustees may meet as often as may be necessary in the trust office for the conduct of the business of trust. All the meeting of the trust shall be held at such time as the Chairman of the Trust shall decide from time to time. However before the expiry of six months from the end of every financial year, the trustees shall meet to adopt the statement of accounts for the financial year and appoint a Chartered Accountant to audit the account of the trust.
- The quorum required for a meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be one third of the trustees.
- The board shall transact only business that may be specified in the agenda or any other matter that may be brought up with permission of the chair.
- iv. The Managing Trustees will act as the chairman of the meeting and in his inability to attend the meeting or in his absence any other trustees elected, as the chairman shall preside over the meeting of the trust.
- v. All decisions of the Board of Trustees may be taken by a simple majority expressly provided for otherwise herein. The Chairman of the meeting shall be entitled to a casting vote in the event of equality of votes at a meeting.
- vi. At least one week's notice in writing shall be given for every meeting for the board of trustees provided however the chairman shall have power to convene a meting at shorter notice for transacting any business considered by him to be urgent, notice of the meeting can be communicated either personally or by written communication.
- vii. The business of trust may also be transacted by circulation of papers. A resolution in writing circulated amongst all trustees and signed by a majority of the trustees shall be as valid and effectual as if it had been at meeting of trustees duly called and convened.
- The Chairman of the meeting shall maintain the proper record of minutes of the Board of Trustees.

13. ACCOUNTS AND ACCOUNTING YEAR

The trust shall maintain account regularly. The account shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant every year as per the requirements of the existing, statutory provisions. Such account shall be inspected by the trustees directly or through their representatives. The accounting year of the trust shall be from the first day of April of a year to the 31st day of March of the following year.

14. AMENDMENTS OF THE TRUST DEED

- The trustees shall make such amendments which would not alter the basic character and objects of the trust, as they find necessary to the trust deed and rules and regulation within the frames work of the trust but no amendments of the trust deed or rules regulations shall be made which may prove repugnant to the provisions of the sections 2(15), 11, 13 and 80G of the Income Tax Act 1961.
- It is hereby made clear that the Board of Trustees shall have power to make from time all such amendments as may be required to secure recognition, exemptions and relief under Income Tax Act or other fiscal laws or as may be found necessary for the smooth working of the trust.
- The provisions of this deed maybe amended if the board of trustees unanimously or by not less than 2/3rd majority so decide.

- The income or funds of the trust will be utilized solely towards the objects of the trust and no portion of it will be distributed in any manner to the manner to the members or any other person specified in section 13(1) (c) of the Income Tax Act, 1961
- Application of income for religious purpose, if any, will be restricted to the limits prescribed under the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time
- Alienation, if any, of the immovable property belonging to trust will be done after due intimation to the Director of Income tax (Exemptions)
- 9. In the event of dissolution or winding up the trust, the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution SHALL not under any circumstance be distributed among the trustees and the same shall be transferred to any other trust/institution with similar objects and enjoying exemption under Section 11 and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961
- 10. The trustees shall be kept indemnified and harmless by the trust against any action, claim, demand or liability arising against them for anything done by them in goal faith, pursuant to power of authority vested in them under these provisions.
- 11. The trust hereby created is irrevocable
- 12. It is expressly declared that no part of the trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any other provisions of law, and other provision hereof shall be constructed accordingly.
